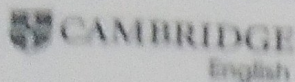
However, I talked to the shopkeeper and said I don't have money but I can get money from bank. Unexpectedly he told me to bring money from the bank.

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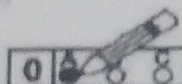

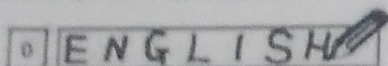
