

## **FLYERS LESSON PLAN (23.03.2026)**

- Recalls how simple present tense verbs are formed and informs the students that feedback has been shared on their answers.
- Engages the students in a listening activity and guides them through a Flyer practice test, focusing on Listening Part 3 and Reading and Writing Part 4.
- The lesson begins with the introduction of the new unit by showing an engaging video related to castles. This helps to capture students' attention and activate their prior knowledge about the topic.
- The teacher then asks an oral question: "Do you like to visit a castle? Why or why not?" Students are encouraged to share their ideas, helping to develop their speaking skills and confidence.
- Next, the teacher guides students to identify different places and things found in a castle (e.g., towers, gates, rooms). Students then complete a matching activity to reinforce their understanding of the vocabulary.
- The teacher asks: "Where are you going to go on this holiday?" and encourages students to respond using future forms such as "going to" and "will." This helps students practice correct sentence structures in a meaningful context.
- Students are then guided through a listening activity, followed by a few speaking activities where they practice using new vocabulary and sentence patterns with their peers.
