

FLYERS - LESSON PLAN 22/06/2026

1. Warmer: A synonym game.

2. Dictation:

Commence the lesson with a dictation. The words were given to students the previous week, and they were provided with sufficient time to study them. After the dictation, students will mark their own answers and announce their scores aloud.

3. Introduction to the New Unit – A Good Year:

Introduce the unit by displaying pictures representing the four seasons: spring, summer, autumn, and winter. Encourage students to identify the seasons and share their ideas and experiences related to each type of weather.

4. Discussion and Book Activity:

Discuss the activities commonly done during each season and guide students to complete the activities on pages 84 and 85 of the textbook.

5. Listening Activity:

Guide students through a listening activity related to winter and discuss the answers.

6. Reading and Comprehension:

Engage students in a reading activity using the story Henry's Holiday. Monitor and assess reading skills as students read the text. Then, guide them in completing the comprehension activities based on the story.
