

FLYERS - LESSON PLAN 29/06/2026

The teacher recalls the four seasons with the students and briefly discusses each season. Special attention is given to winter, including simple vocabulary and ideas related to it. Then students are engaged in a short listening activity based on winter to build understanding and interest.

Students listen to a short conversation carefully. After listening, the teacher selects two students to act out the dialogue in front of the class to develop speaking and confidence.

Students take part in another listening activity where they listen to different speakers. They identify who is speaking and what each person is talking about, focusing on careful listening skills.

Students are given reading and writing practice activities based on Flyers practice tests. They read the given texts and complete the related tasks with teacher support when needed.

The teacher reads out 10 present tense verbs clearly. Students listen and write them down, then convert each verb into its past tense form to reinforce grammar knowledge.

Students complete a Reading Part 7 task where they look at three pictures and write a short story in the past tense, focusing on sequence and sentence formation.

The teacher revises the story “Henry’s Holiday” with the students. After revision, students complete the remaining comprehension activities related to the story.
