

KET LESSON PLAN (01.04.2026)

- Begins the lesson by discussing the homework assigned in the previous week, which focused on writing a text message. Students are encouraged to read their answers aloud and share them with their classmates.
- Engages students in an interesting Speaking Part 2 activity related to school subjects, allowing them to express their ideas and opinions confidently.
- Introduces the new unit, “Let’s Go to the Museum.” Displays the two pictures on the first page and encourages a discussion comparing village and city life, focusing on aspects such as what they can see, the atmosphere, cultural practices, and lifestyle differences.
- Guides students through Reading Part 1, where they read short texts and select the correct answers. Provides support and clarification where necessary.
- Recalls the past tense and explains the rules of:
 - a) Verb “to be” in the past tense
 - b) Regular (other) verbs
 - c) Irregular verbs
- Reinforces learning through an engaging game and follows up with several writing activities to practice these forms.
- Introduces vocabulary related to buildings. Students identify each building from pictures and write the correct names beneath them.
- Concludes the lesson with a listening activity, allowing students to practice their listening and comprehension skills.
