

KET LESSON PLAN (01.05.2026)

- The lesson begins with a discussion of the homework assigned on the Past Continuous Tense, ensuring students clarify any doubts and consolidate their understanding.
- Next, the teacher explains how to approach Reading Part 2 and guides students through practice activities to actively engage them in the reading task.
- The lesson then moves on to introducing music genres. The teacher explains what music genres are, supported by clear meanings, visual aids, and examples of popular singers and bands. Students participate in a listening activity to reinforce their understanding.
- Following this, the teacher presents the usage of can and could through a poster that highlights their meanings and provides examples. Students are encouraged to contribute additional examples for each modal verb and then complete related writing tasks to apply their knowledge.
- Students are further engaged in revising key grammar components, including articles, pronouns, verbs, prepositions, quantifiers, and modals. They explain each concept with examples and complete writing activities, including an email writing task.
- The lesson concludes with Speaking Part 1 practice. Students are paired and encouraged to ask and answer questions from page 61, promoting fluency and confidence in spoken English.
