

KET- LESSON PLAN 29/07/2026

- Completes the grammar review activities from Lessons 10 and 11.
- Recalls the First Conditional, which was introduced two weeks ago, and engages students in the remaining writing activities.
- Identifies different parts of the body and discusses why each part is important. Engages students in a guessing and pair-speaking activity.
- Engages students in a listening activity, highlighting the importance of focusing on the main idea of the listening track to answer each question correctly.
- Explains the use of something, anything, nothing, etc. in relation to people, things, and places. Explains the meanings with suitable examples using a colourful poster and engages students in related writing activities.
- Introduces the question “What’s the matter?” and explains that it is commonly used when someone is sick or has a problem. Discusses how doctors may ask this question to patients and how patients can respond by describing their symptoms, e.g., “I have a headache.”
