

KET - LESSON PLAN - 28/01/2026

1. Explains the usage of 'some' and 'any' with countable and uncountable nouns. Gets a few examples from the students to ensure that they understand the rules. Guides the students to complete writing activities related to this.
2. Lets the students listen to a track and complete the missing words in a note provided, related to a cake competition.
3. Explains the use of how much / how many / a few / a little / a lot of with examples. Gets examples from the students as well and guides them to complete activities related to this grammar.
4. Introduces some food phrases such as a slice of bread and a bowl of chips, and asks the students to provide more examples. Conducts a speaking activity where students talk about what they usually have for breakfast.
5. Supports the students in completing an email.
6. Guides the students through Speaking Part 2. Displays pictures and asks the students to describe each picture. Encourages them to say whether they like these activities as hobbies and to provide reasons.
