LESSON: Our Summer Holidays

OBJECTIVES

- Recalls the previous lesson about summer holidays.
- Engages in a speaking activity.
- Recognizes the ways of asking questions that begin with "Have you ever"
- Identifies the difference between regular and irregular verbs.
- Engages in extra worksheets

DEVELOPMENT OF THE LESSON

1. Warmer: Guessing the word
2. Recalls what a summer holiday is and what people do during this period.
3. Engages in a speaking activity.
4. Let the students guess the things that they need to take on a skiing holiday, camping holiday and beach holiday.
5. Guides students to complete page 93.
6. Engages in a listening activity.
7. Explains on how to ask questions that begin with "have you ever"? (Highlights the fact that verb should be in past participle).
8. Engages in an extra activity and games in order to reinforce the understanding of questions that begin with "have you ever"?
9. Guides the students to complete page 94.
10. Explains what regular and irregular verbs with examples are.
11. Shows a video and ask the students to guess the past participle form of the verb. (Game)
12. Pair up the students and guide them to ask questions with "have you ever?" by using the words given in page 95.
13. Guides the students to complete Home-fun booklet page 22 and 23.
